TEXAS VOTES TO LOWER PROPERTY TAXES

Proposition 1 is a measure to lower school district property taxes for homeowners who are 65 and older or disabled. This proposition passed by a wide margin. Under Proposition 1, those homeowners could qualify for those additional reductions in 2023.



Proposition 2 Raises the deduction amount homeowners can deduct from their home's value before school district taxes are levied on homestead properties. The amount went from 25,000 to 40,000.
